

## Bourgogne Chardonnay



Grape Variety: Chardonnay.

Surface: Les Canottes (at Corpeau-Puligny) 0.39 ha and Les Grands Clous Perrons (at Meursault) 0.075 ha. Planted between 1951 and 1962.


Soil : Clay

The soils are tilled then grassed over. Minimum treatments. Manual harvest with systematic sorting. Precise choice of harvest date based on maturity checks.

## VINIFICATION

Long, gentle pneumatic pressing, followed by overnight settling.

Alcoholic fermentation takes place partially in stainless steel vats. The wine is then transferred into barrels (15% new) for its malolactic fermentation and maturing for 12 months after which it is racked into stainless steel vats and aged for a further 6 months before bottling.
