

Volnay 1er Cru LE RONCERET



Grape variety: Pinot Noir.

Surface: A parcel of 0.2073 ha.

Planted in 1980.

Soil: Very stony limestone clay, with little arable soil.

Southeast orientation.

Soils are tilled then grassed over. Minimum treatments. Manual harvest with systematic sorting. Precise choice of harvest date based on maturity checks.


It is the name of a climate that englobes Le Ronceret and part of Les Aussy. It was formerly covered in bushes and brambles that had to be cleared for planting.

VINIFICATION

50% whole bunch vinification.

Cold pre-fermentation maceration, followed by a period of 15 days in vat.

Aged in oak barrels (around 20% new), for 18 months, then racked into stainless steel vats before bottling..
