## Bourgogne Aligoté - 2023



“A nicely open nose – that’s a great invitation. Juicy energy, here’s a great aligote so delicious – that’s clearly a great one.” **Bill Nanson - Burgundy Report**

“Pale colour, with lively Aligoté fruit, lime and greengage, sweetly ripe yet still bristling with vigour from Aligoté’s higher acidity. Fills the greengage, sweetly ripe yet still bristling with vigour from Aligoté’s higher acidity. Fills the palate beautifully.”

## Bourgogne Chardonnay - 2023

“The bouquet is opulent with ripe pears and yellow plums, both spicy and crystalline at the same time. Lovely energy across the palate and finishing with a crisper white fruit than the nose was suggesting, pears and apples together, very persistent.” **100pt score : 88-90 Jasper Morris - Inside Burgundy**

## Bourgogne Les Pellans - 2023



“More aromatic impact. Fine scale – not a Bourgogne finish – it’s way better than that – a super finish with impressive width.” **Bill Nanson**

“Clear mid lemon yellow. Less immediately ripe, so a little more tension. There is a crystalline steely character across the palate with a fresh citrus overtone, and a long mineral finish. More reserved than the straight Bourgogne Blanc, a very different style of wine.”

“The 2023 Bourgogne Les Pellans, from a single 0.60ha parcel, has a fresh, mineral-driven bouquet with real drive and focus. The palate is very well balanced with a fresh citrus entry, touches of orange rind and lemon zest. It's vibrant towards the finish. Excellent.”

## Bourgogne Pinot Noir - 2023



“A pretty light ruby colour. The nose is stunning, with little red cherries, and the wine continues to wind its elegant way across the palate, with very refined tannins and excellent persistence.”

“The 2023 Bourgogne Rouge, aged 25% in amphora, comes from three lieux-dits. It has a crisp nose with blackcurrant and raspberry scents and a touch of briar. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy red fruit, a gentle grip and good concentration on the finish.”

## Auxey-Duresses Les Hautés - 2023

“Lemon and lime colour. The nose is intriguing, adequately ripe yet with the greener notes from this north-east facing vineyard. A similar sucrosity appears on the palate with a greater depth of flavour than the Monthelie. Very attractively balanced throughout.”

“This 2023 shows another, very well-defined bouquet with crushed limestone-infused yellow-tinged fruit, conveying a sense of energy. The palate is very well balanced with impressive depth and good concentration. It is very pure, with a touch of fresh Clementines on the finish. Delightful.”

## Auxey-Duresses Les Closeaux - 2023

“Silky red fruit with – 40% whole clusters were used. Depth of flavour, silky, tasty and great finishing – I love it.”

“A fine ruby with a pinker edge. The same heady bouquet with refined cherries and floral touch. This really attractive and superfine across the palate, with a clean-cut tension to finish. Alpine strawberries at the back. There is no duresses in this Auxey !”

“The 2023 Auxey-Duresses Les Closeaux was 40% whole clusters. Dark berry fruit mixed with touches of black tea aromas unfold on the nose. The palate is sapid on the entry with fine concentration. Then again, this is a Village, not a Premier Cru.”

### Chassagne-Montrachet La Platière - 2023

“More lemon yellow in the colour. The nose is not very forthcoming. After a while some ripe lemon zest appears, exuberant lift on the palate, clean white fruit behind still infused by the citrus zest. Understated yet fine and long.”

**100pt score : 90-92 Jasper Morris - Inside Burgundy**

“The 2023 Chassagne-Montrachet La Platière offers light Crustacea scents on the nose. The palate is more promising and harmonious, with a smooth texture and crisp acidity with orchard fruit on the finish. Very fine.”

### Chassagne-Montrachet Premier Cru Les Chaumées - 2023

“Mid lemon yellow. Super-ripe nose, honeydew melon and honeysuckle. Peaches too, a bit exaggerated. It is actually very charming, but less classical. Peach and grenadine notes.”

“Chassagne-Montrachet Les Chaumées has a straightforward citrus-fresh, slightly floral bouquet with hints of orange pith. The palate is mineral-driven with greater depth than the La Platière, linear and focused with an elegant finish, a light brush of pear on the aftertaste.”

### Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru - 2023

“Really forward, more floral perfumed, some acacia in this. Really, large scale, vibrant, electric energy with more sweetness of finish. Bravo !!”

“A clear mid lemon yellow. The bouquet shows class with reserve. The ripeness seems perfectly judged. Fresh apples, then a little wash of lemon, the minerals of Corton-Charlemagne with exceptional persistence. There is such a strong tensile strength. Understated, lingering, classical wine.”

“The bouquet is intense: yellow plum, jasmine and hints of white truffle emerge with aeration. The palate is tensile and mineral-driven, with real tension and mineralité. It's a linear and strict style of Corton-Charlemagne with a pleasant bitterness on the finish. This is a very serious white Burgundy that will age with style.”

## Meursault Les Grands Charrons - 2023



“A nose with more impact – these are vines planted in 1929. Large scale in the mouth, melting flavours that are complex and engaging – it’s a beauty.”

**Bill Nanson - Burgundy Report**

“Mid lemon colour. The bouquet is somewhat reserved, perhaps just a sign of the intensity to come. The palate however delivers a very high-class Meursault, with several layers of predominantly white fruit backed up by an impeccable structure. Very long finish indeed.”

“The 2023 Meursault Les Grands Charrons comes from vines planted in 1929. The palate is very well balanced, with a lovely bitter lemon note on the entry. It's a Meursault refined and elegant. A long-term prospect.”

## Meursault Les Crotots - 2023

“Pale lemon colour. Some tension is immediately apparent on the nose. Ripe apples, white fruit, perhaps a touch of plum behind. A fine depth of fruit behind from this lower slope vineyard, with plenty of energy at the finish.”

“The 2023 Meursault Crotots has a tightly wound bouquet, a little timid at the moment, perhaps biding its time. The palate is strict and linear.”

## Meursault Les Luchets - 2023



“Clear pale lemon. Some white fruit but nothing much is showing as yet. Once again in this fine line-up of exemplary whites from Pierre Vincent, the backbone is very apparent, alongside concentrated apples, a little citrus and a touch of sandalwood. A fresh style of Meursault.”

“The 2023 Meursault Les Luchets is a cuvée aged in a combination of barrels and clay jars. This has an earthy, stony, almost loamy bouquet that is very intense and well-defined. The palate is clean and precise, and real tension and energy are coiled up in this Meursault with an almost Puligny-like, slightly more malic finish. Superb.”

### Meursault Premier Cru **Les Charmes** - 2023

“Hmm, floral aromatics. Large in scale, very Charmes, very long too – that’s a great finish !!” **Bill Nanson - Burgundy Report**

“This impeccable Meursault Charmes fills the mouth impressively, with an excellent mix between the perfectly judged ripeness of the white fruit and a little oak. The flavours linger beautifully on the palate.”

“It has a very well-defined bouquet with mineral-rich yellow fruit, a hint of walnut and sea spray. The palate shows a fine bead of acidity.”

### Monthelie Premier Cru **Les Duresses** - 2023

“A solid ruby colour. There is significant concentration of dark red fruit on the nose, on the firmer side, again barely showing whole bunch character. The Monthelie is vibrating with energy on the palate, backed by good acidity, and adequate tannins behind. Blacker fruit in fact at the back.”

“The 2023 Monthéles Les Duresses 1er Cru contains 50% whole clusters. Wild strawberry and loamy scents unfurl on the nose, well-defined with a touch of allspice. The palate is more complex than the Volnay, the tannins slightly finer with a precise and saline finish.”

### Monthelie **Les Sous-Roches** - 2023

“Aromas which bring a white flower width. Mouth-filling, fluid, mouth-watering. Gorgeous wine – not many words needed.”

“Very pale colour, with a nose which shows the limestone character. On the leaner side, but then there is a coating of a citrus sucrosity on top of the bone structure. The flavours do linger very nicely.”

“The 2023 Monthélie Les Sous-Roches comes from limestone soils with an easterly exposure. The palate is fresh and saline on the entry, with moderate depth, a twist of sour lemon and a pinch of lemongrass towards the finish.”

### Puligny-Montrachet - 2023



“An even mid lemon yellow. The nose has a soft generosity of orchard fruit, without the citrus touch. The wine keeps expanding on the palate, with an essential thread of acidity to maintain freshness and deliver backbone. Exceptionally persistent, a very fine Puligny in the making.”

“Cold dark sea cave and touches of oyster shell unfold on the nose. The palate is superb and well-defined with a silver bead of acidity that is precise and focused. A citrus-fresh finish lingers in the mouth. The 2023 touches Premier Cru in quality.”

### Puligny-Montrachet Premier Cru Les Referts - 2023

“A Mid lemon yellow. Not quite as evocative on the nose as the Charmes. However, there is a solid powerful density on the palate, a little more earthbound, with a lick of oak behind. The acid balance is very helpful at the finish.”

“It has a minimalist, Zen-like bouquet that is pure mineralité - almost flinty in style. The palate is well-defined, with ample weight and notes of orange zest and mango. It's energetic and lightly spiced towards the finish. This is one of the strongest wines from Pierre Vincent this vintage.”

### Savigny-Les-Beaune Premier Cru Aux Vergelesses - 2023



“Pale with a faint green streak. There is a herbal aspect to the nose giving a light reductive note on top of clean white fruit. Well defined stony notes on the palate, a very light citrus, and a long clean finish.”

“It has a pixelated bouquet with white peach, light lemon zest aromas and a touch of oyster shell. The palate is well balanced with impressive weight and concentration. Dried honey and quince notes appear with some mineralité tucked in just underneath. This is the dark horse of the range - don't ignore this.”

### Volnay Ez Blanches - 2023

“Lovely width of aroma here – this has an even silkier red fruit nose. Elegant shape, lovely velvet texture – beautiful in the finish.”

“Rather deeper in colour, more crimson than ruby. There is a fine bundle of fruit across the palate, dark strawberry fruit, not showing the whole bunches. Slightly drier at the finish.”

“It has a lively, slightly leafy bouquet. The palate is medium-bodied, with sappy red berry fruit mixed with white pepper and a minerally finish that errs towards Pommard in structure. Very fine.”

### Volnay Premier Cru Le Ronceret - 2023

“Mid crimson purple. Taking time to tease out the nose. There is plenty of fruit weight here, more red than black, lifted towards the back of the palate with a little white pepper and good acidity. The 1er Cru quality really shows the further back you go on the palate, with an engaging complex yet very refined finish.”

“The 2023 Volnay Le Ronceret 1er Cru is definitely a step up from the Ez Blanches. The 50% whole bunches impart light peppery scents, ample fruit concentration and wonderful delineation. The palate is medium-bodied with crunchy red fruit and fine acidity. Again, it is Pommard-like in style, with a strict, black pepper and graphite-tinged finish.”
