

JASPER MORRIS Inside|Burgundy



Jasper Morris is one of Britain's leading experts on Burgundy wines. Based in France since the 1970s, he founded the Morris & Verdin wine merchant in 1981, helping to raise the profile of many Burgundy estates in the United Kingdom.

After selling his business in 2003, he devoted himself entirely to writing and criticism. His book *Inside Burgundy* (2010) quickly became an essential reference on the region.

Founder of the Inside Burgundy website, he is renowned for his methodical approach, his precision and his encyclopaedic knowledge of Burgundy terroirs.





DOMAINE PIERRE VINCENT



Bourgogne *Aligoté* - 2024

“Pale colour, racy nose an absolutely archetypal Aligoté. Real zest on the palate, not just fresh citrus but an excellent minéral feel, very racy, and with just a little flesh assisted by the barrel ageing. Drink from 2027-2030.”

Bourgogne *Chardonnay* - 2024

“Pale lemon colour. An immediate sense of finesse this is understated, but obviously carries a fine quality of adequately ripe fruit with impeccable texture. I am keeping this in my mouth as long as possible. Really gracious stylish wine here at the finish.”

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Bourgogne *Les Pellans* - 2024

“Mid lemon in colour. The bouquet is clearly just a notch richer than the blended Bourgogne. Very old vines contribute to the concentration with an excellent mineral underlay. Strikingly vibrant, a little more of everything though I am still taken by the finesse of the regular Bourgogne.”

Bourgogne *Pinot Noir* - 2024

“Mid crimson. Some stems, some light red fruit though I suspect more will emerge - this is a cool sample in a cold cellar of course. Light in the mouth, modest in concentration, a little redcurrant fruit, not too much pepper, yet quite a gracefully extended finish, 20% new wood hardly shows.”

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Auxey-Duresses *Les Closeaux* - 2024

“Between crimson and ruby with a fine red fruit energy. No obvious stems on the nose, much more so in the mouth. But the fruit energy pretty much covers the stems though there is quite a fierce white pepper. Fine length.”

Auxey-Duresses *Les Hautés* - 2024

“Mid lemon yellow. A much more solid bouquet than the nevery Monthélie. There’s a bit more flesh on the palate too, this is quite complete with a finish that keeps expanding. This part of Auxey is now being recognised as a great source for whites.”

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Chassagne-Montrachet Premier Cru *Les Chaumées* - 2024

“One barrel only. Fresh lemon pale lemon. Quite strongly reductive in character on the nose. A chiselled purity otherwise to the crisp white fruit, with fine tensile strength. The Chaumées just needs to shake off the reductive character. The finish shows excellent promise.”

Chassagne-Montrachet *La Platière* - 2024

“Pale in colour, with a discreet but relatively noble bouquet. Very little reduction, just orchard fruit showing in a discreet fashion. Despite the relative understatement, the fruit picks up speed; on the palate and delivers a particularly fine aftertaste, with fruit, flesh and mineral acidity all in harness.”

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Corton-Charlemagne Grand Cru - 2024

“Pale lemon in colour. A bouquet of such quintessential mineral refinement. Classy understatement. This is so tightly wound that I am far from sure I am seeing everything in it. Totally electric in style, fine-boned, delicate detail but the tensile strength is so evident that the delicacy is sustainable. Makes many other examples seem vulgar !”

Meursault *Les Luchets* - 2024

“A fine lemon colour. The bouquet is also particularly refined. The 2024 Luchets is absolutely dancing in the glass, with a mineral uplift to support the fine white fruit which dominates the palate. A particular fine touch to the texture.”

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Meursault *Les Crotots* - 2024

“One barrel only. Pale in colour, with same fresh fruit on the nose, includes citrus as well as orchard fruit. Some riper notes appear on the palate, the lightest hint of peaches, and the oak marries in very well. An excellent finish.”

Meursault *Les Grands Charrons* - 2024

“A fuller yellow with huge density on the palate. The Grandss Charrons has much more flesh, showing the oak more too, and perhaps less acidity. In fact, this is not the easiest to taste. Certainly, it has a fine long finish, and the flesh fulfils Meursault expectations.”

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Meursault Premier Cru *Les Charmes* - 2024

“Mid lemon yellow. A reduction here too but as much gun flint as struck match. There is depth and weight of orchard fruit beneath. Tangy too, chiselled citrus skin, possibly even mandarin, a characterful Charmes of promise.”

Monthelie Premier Cru *Les Dureses* - 2024

“A slightly lighter crimson with tiled edges. Gentle red fruit on the nose. Raspberry with a drier edge but assimilating the stems very well, with a long and quite graceful finish. On the cusp of cherry and raspberry.”

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Monthélie *Les Sous-Roches* - 2024

“A cooler style of bouquet, more reductive than fruit driven. Very brisk on the palate, saline at the finish with both lemon and lime juice adding to the seasoning.”

Puligny-Montrachet - 2024

“A little more weight on the nose than the Chassagne, some eau de vide de poire which I think is more from the barrel. Nicely nuanced, with some ripe citrus skins keeping the balance, and fair length. Indeed, it keeps staying with me after tasting.”

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Puligny-Montrachet Premier Cru *Les Referts* - 2024

“Light lime and lemon in colour. The bouquet is exquisite with much more Puligny style reduction than is typical from Referts, on the Meursault border. Old vines picked at the right time will make good wine, says Pierre, and he does indeed know how to make good wine.”

Savigny-les-Beaune Premier Cru *Aux Vergelesses* - 2024

“Mid lemon colour. A lighter bouquet, white fruit infused with some stones. Fresh pears just a trace of citrus, well constructed white fruit continues through the middle then a stylish mineral aftertaste. This should come round relatively quickly.”

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Volnay Ez Blanches - 2024

“Mid crimson with lighter rim. I am not finding much on the nose yet. A fuller strawberry and raspberry fruit only lightly spiced, with a good length. Good acidity should help protect from anything untoward.”

Volnay Premier Cru Le Ronceret - 2024

“A vivid ruby with just a little more of the fresh red fruit. There is pepper on top as well, but not dominant. A wave of high class fresh red fruit on the palate, covering the structure nicely, and very persistent little red fruits to finish The 1er Cru Ronceret seems to be the best equipped to manage the whole bunch regime in this cellar.”
